

2009 Rookie Honor Society & Rookie of the Year Application

For NEAR REALTOR® members only.

- ★ The Rookie Honor Society will be comprised of and recognize the Top 10 Rookies in the two categories of achievement in Units and Volume, with **minimum criteria set at: \$3 million or 10 sides.**
- ★ Of these ten agents, one will be honored with Rookie of the Year for Total Volume and another for Rookie of the Year for Total Units. One person may be eligible to receive both awards.
- ★ Applicant must have demonstrated ethical conduct. Someone having been found guilty of unethical conduct will not be considered for the award.
- ★ Rookie status is applicable to an agent's **first full 12-month year** (beginning January 1 the year following their license date), therefore, January 1, 2009 to December 31, 2009 is their first full year for award consideration at the 2010 Recognition Gala. Examples:
 1. Mary became licensed in March 2008. Her first full 12-month year is January 1, 2009 to December 31, 2009, and she is eligible for Rookie status award consideration at the 2010 Gala.
 2. John became licensed in February 2009. His first full 12-month year will not begin until January 1, 2010. He will be eligible for Rookie status award consideration at the 2011 Gala.
